Greetings all,

It is hard to believe, but the summer season for 2019 is already over halfway completed with the fourth week of camp ending today. This summer marks the first summer with all female troops attending camp and they have been welcomed as any other new unit that attends Sequassen. The projects funded by the Alumni last fall are being very well received. The First Year Camper area is very appreciative of the new pavilion and it has created a great base of operation for the program working with the newest members of the Sequassen family.
